
London (4 nights) – Amsterdam (3 nights) – Paris (5 nights)

Sunday, June 16 – London: Welcome Drink and Welcome Dinner by the River Bank.

Participants arrive in London from the morning to early afternoon. Private drivers will greet participants at the airport and provide transfer from Heathrow International Airport to the hotel, which is centrally located close to the Tower Bridge. In the late afternoon, we'll meet as a group for a **Welcome Drink** and Program Introduction. Afterwards, a **Welcome Dinner** will be hosted at a local restaurant located by Shakespeare's Globe, with stunning views of the Thames and St Paul's Cathedral.

Monday, June 17 – London Sightseeing Tour, Queen's Gallery and Royal Mews at Buckingham Palace.

We'll start the day with a private guided tour of some of London's major sites, such as **Westminster Abbey, Saint Paul's Cathedral** and the **Tower of London**. The tour will end at Buckingham Palace, where we will visit the **Queen's Gallery** to see a special exhibition, **Leonardo Da Vinci – A Life in Drawing**, with over 200 of his drawings displayed. We'll also visit the **Royal Mews**, home to historic royal carriages and one of the finest working stables in existence.

Tuesday, June 18 – Symposium at the Gordon Museum of Pathology with Private Lecture and Visit to the Old Operating Theatre Museum.

In the morning, we'll attend a private symposium at the **Gordon Museum of Pathology at the King's College**, where lectures will be given by the curator and a ceroplastic art historian. They will talk about the anatomical, pathological and dermatological collections for medical teaching and the difference between the Italian and the European school of wax model art. A Q&A session will be held during a walk and talk visit of the museum. Afterwards, enjoy some leisure time and lunch on your own at the nearby, trendy **Borough Market**.

In the afternoon, we'll visit the **Old Operating Theatre Museum**, which is housed in the attic of an early eighteenth-century church of the old St Thomas' Hospital. There will be a presentation on *The Foundations of Contemporary Attitudes Towards Health, Illness, and the Body*.

Wednesday, June 19 – Windsor Castle and the Wellcome Library.

In the morning, we'll reach the charming village of Windsor via one-hour train ride. Upon arrival, we will visit the wonderful and fascinating **Windsor Castle**, home to the Queen and over 900 years of royal history. Afterwards, there will be an opportunity to walk around and enjoy the village on your own. In the afternoon, we'll return to London and enjoy a private visit of the **Wellcome Library**, which will be hosted by the curator who will present some of the most important ancient books related to the history of anatomy.

Thursday, June 20 – Travel to Amsterdam, Visit to Waag Anatomy Theater and Dinner.

In the morning, check-out from the hotel and group transfer to London St. Pancras train station. We'll travel to Amsterdam by high-speed direct train in premium class reserved seats. Arrival at Amsterdam Central Station early in the afternoon followed by private transfer to our hotel. The hotel is housed in a row of 17th century buildings along the **Singel**, which is Amsterdam's oldest major canal. Check-in at hotel and enjoy some time at your leisure.

In the late afternoon, we'll have a private visit of **The Waag's Theatrum Anatomicum**, built in 1691 as a space dedicated to advanced experimenting, observing and learning. Following the visit, we'll have **dinner** at a traditional restaurant located in the same building, illuminated by candles.

Friday, June 21– Amsterdam Sightseeing Tour, Amsterdam Museum and Museum Vrolik.

In the morning, we'll discover Amsterdam by foot with a private tour guide, including stops at the Begijnhof, Rembrandt's house and the historical Jewish neighborhood. The tour continues to the **Amsterdam Museum**, which hosts the most important anatomy-related paintings from the 17th century, including of course, those by Rembrandt.

In the afternoon, we will visit the **Museum Vrolik** at the School of Medicine, where we will have a guided tour of the normal and pathological anatomy specimens displayed there.

Saturday, June 22 – The Hague and the Mauritshuis Museum.

In the morning, we will reach the charming city of **The Hague** by a one-hour train ride. We will visit the **Mauritshuis Museum**, home to some of the best paintings from The Dutch Golden Age, including masterpieces such as Vermeer's *Girl with a Pearl Earring* and *The Anatomy Lesson of Dr. Nicolaes Tulp*, by Rembrandt. After the visit, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore The Hague, or head back to Amsterdam to visit other museums on your own, such as the Rijksmuseum, the Van Gogh Museum or the Anne Frank House.

Sunday, June 23 – Travel to Paris and Parisian Dinner.

Check-out and private group transfer to Amsterdam Central Station. Travel to Paris by the high-speed direct train in premium class reserved seats. Arrival at Paris Gare du Nord station in the early afternoon. Private group transfer to our hotel located by the vibrant Latin Quarter, on the Left Bank of the Seine, close to Sorbonne University. Check-in and enjoy some time at leisure. Prior to dinner, we'll go on a short walking tour to get familiar with the area. This will be followed by **dinner** at a traditional brasserie for a real Parisian experience.

Monday, June 24 – Paris Sightseeing Tour and The Louvre.

Tour of Paris by private coach with commentary by a professional tour guide, driving from district to district and stopping at major points of interest, such as **Notre Dame Cathedral**, the **Eiffel Tower**, the **Arc de Triomphe**, the **Champs Elysées**, and the artist village of **Montmartre**. Once there, we will have time at leisure for lunch and to explore the charming streets. In the afternoon, we will head to the **Louvre** where we will be led by a private tour guide through one of the most famous museums in the world, which includes the celebrated *Mona Lisa* by Leonardo Da Vinci.

Tuesday, June 25 – Palace of Versailles Guided Tour and Wine and Cheese Pairing Lunch.

In the morning, we will travel by private coach to the immense estate of Versailles, with its chateaus and gardens, turned into an extravagant residence by Louis XIV, the Sun King. Our private tour guide will tell us all the secrets behind the scenes while walking through apartments, salons, galleries and beautiful gardens. After the visit, to remain in the royal mood, we will experience a cheese and wine pairing lunch at a private chateau. Return to Paris in the late afternoon.

Wednesday, June 26 – Optional Excursion to Normandy and D-Day Landing Beaches.

For those interested, we will organize a full-day trip dedicated to the memory of the heroes of the last world war. This will include a charming visit of the Normandy region, famous for producing cider, calvados liquor, the unrivalled Camembert cheese and historical medieval cities. This excursion will be quoted separately. Alternatively, other optional excursions can be arranged such as a trip to the Champagne region or Loire Castles.

Thursday, June 27 – The Museum of History of Medicine and Farewell Dinner.

Enjoy the morning at leisure to explore the city on your own. Recommendations include the Musee d'Orsay, farmers markets, the Catacombs of Paris, river cruise and much more. In the afternoon, we will visit the **Museum of the History of Medicine** located by the University Paris Descartes. In the evening, we will conclude our program with a special **Farewell Dinner** at a traditional Parisian restaurant.

Friday, June 28 – Departure from Paris.

Check-out from hotel and group transfers to Paris Charles De Gaulle airport.
